What is the Dickinson Scholarship?

The Dickinson Scholarship is presented to a person entering the library profession, or a school librarian in active service, to go toward college tuition for a school library program.

Scholastic Record

A brief summary of the applicant's scholastic record.

Philosophy Statement

A statement of the applicant's philosophy of the role of a school librarian. No more than one page.

Three Letters of Recommendation

Include letters from a school librarian or college instructor in librarianship, school principal or college advisor, and a person of the applicant's choosing.

Format Required

Download the Dickinson Scholarship Application. Use the framework for completing the application. Upload final copies as a PDF file. The application and supporting documents should be uploaded as one file. These can be exported as a PDF from most word processing, presentation, or scanning software.
